Abstract Title: Sharing EHR data between NF, MD, & LTC Pharmacy using CMS Standard messages

Session Outline: LTPAC care is impossible without Physicians. Their signature on conforming orders is a prerequisite for 100% of Part A and Medicaid payments.

This session identifies the role played by physicians in LTPAC, and proven strategies for engaging them through existing ONC/CMS mandates for the use of CHERT, and exchanging data between LTC facilities, Physicians, and Pharmacies using CMS mandated message formats.

- How to use mandated standards to connect LTPAC facilities/physicians/pharmacies

- Compare - Contrast CEHRT message standards with Transfer/Transition of care messages via an HIE
